She was placed under suspension on account of repeated misbehavior reported by the Principal of Ayurvedic College, with her apart from the above instances. She was also found evading the Enquiry Committee on the pretext that she had been ill (without Medical Certificate from the competent authority) whereas on the other hand, she was busy in sending legal notice to the University. The BOM also has gone through the complaint sent by Ms. Dhanpati Devi to UGC, which came to the notice of the University after her suspension, in which she has used derogatory language against the entire Administration.

Taking into account the totality of the case, it was unanimously resolved that the services of Ms. Dhanpati Devi be terminated with immediate effect with three month salary in lieu of the notice period. The BOM observed that now there is no need to conduct the enquiry in this case. The language used by her against the Administration as a whole alone is the *prima facie* a case of gross indiscipline, misconduct and insubordination.

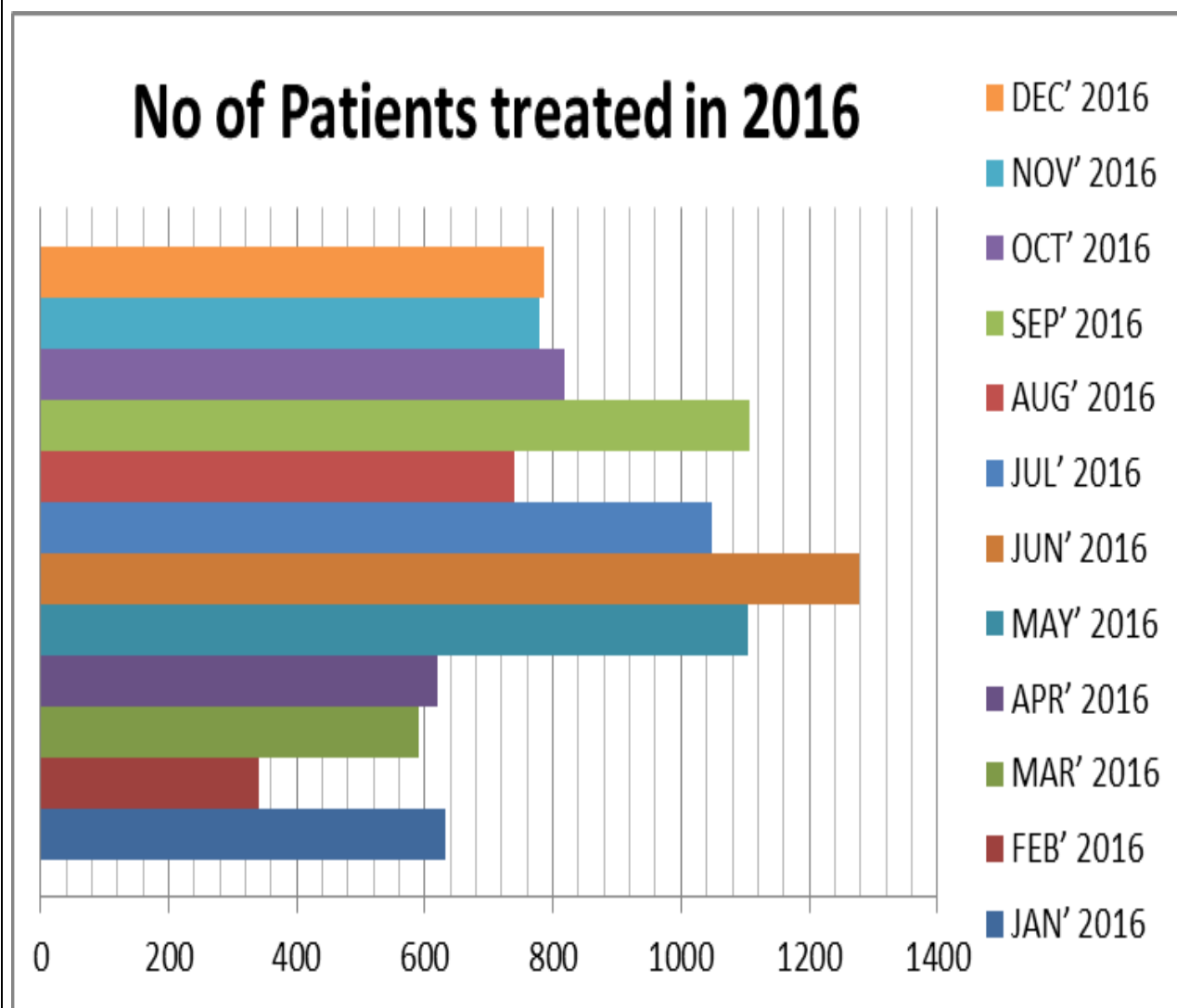

Both University library and Department of library science are following the national international standards for creating library data base of available documents and for study and learning programmes of Library Science Department.
