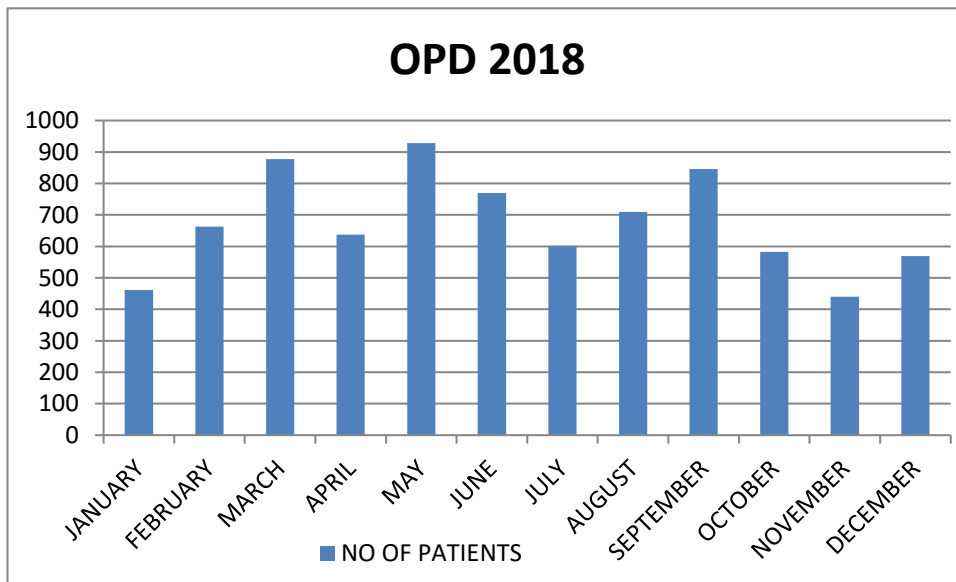


Figure: Bar diagram showing month-wise details of patients visited in Physiotherapy OPD.

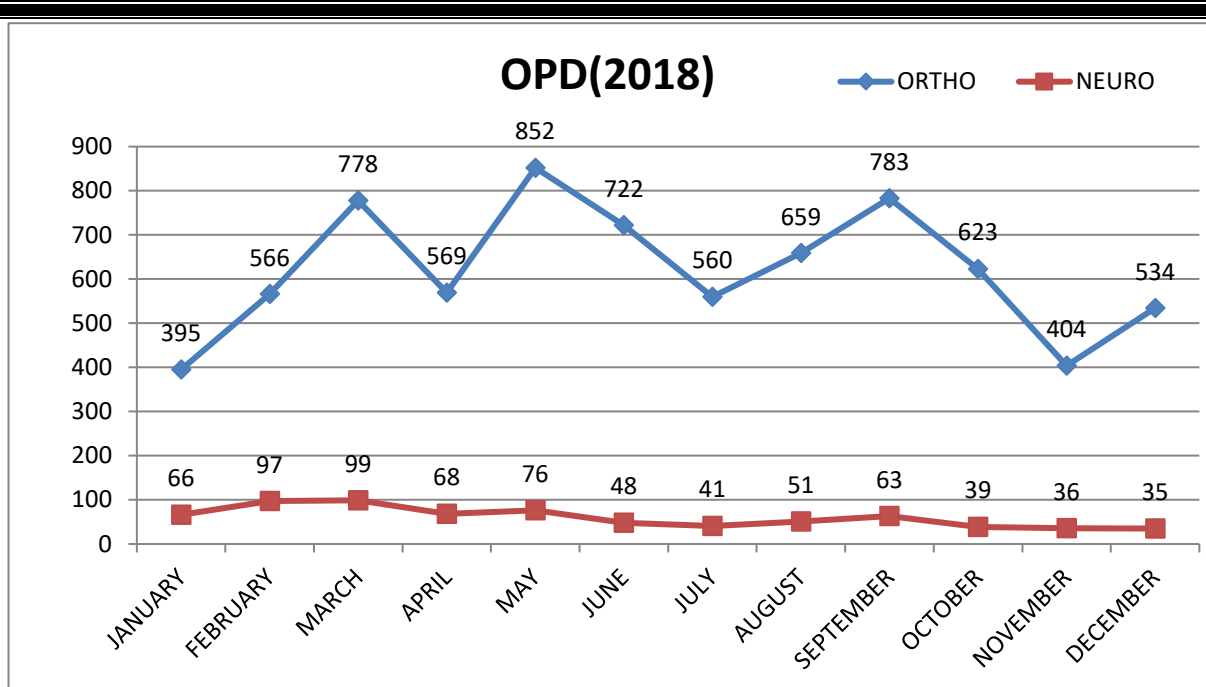


Figure: Line diagram showing month-wise details of patients visited in Ortho and Neuro Physiotherapy OPD.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

Baba Mastnath University Library System is functioning smoothly with a rich collection of 40863 documents and subscribing 141 current journals (i.e., 117 Indian and 24 foreign journals). The university library system comprises of one Central Library and 10 Departmental libraries spread over to almost all the faculties of the University for easy and convenient access to library documents. The Central library, BMU is functioning with a rich collection of 11110 documents, including books, learned journals, magazines, and newspapers in a well furnished, well maintained and modernized library building. The library environment for study, learning and research is conducive and inviting. There are 16 staff members in Baba Mastnath University Library System and library functions six days a week from 8.30 am to 4.30 pm. University library staff is also looking after the Department of Library and Information Science.
