MINUTES OF NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC) MEETING

A meeting of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), BMU, Rohtak was held on May 1st, 2025 at Vice Chancellor Office, Administrative Block under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. H.L. Verma, Baba Mastnath University, Rohtak, to review the progress and accomplishment of data acquisition of Criteria V and Criteria VI as per the NAAC accreditation criteria.

Following points were discussed

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) convened a detailed meeting on 1st May 2025 at 3:15 PM in the Vice Chancellor's Office to assess the progress of NAAC-related documentation under Criteria V and VI, as per the Binary Accreditation Framework. The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. H. L. Verma. The session began with a focused discussion on Criterion VI, with the presence of key members including Prof. Sudhir

Malik (Convener), Dr. J.K. Sharma, Dr. Sonia Saroha, Dr. Charu Sharma, Dr. Anil Dudy, Dr. Bablu Sharma, and Dr. Monika Chahar.

The Vice Chancellor emphasized the formalization of domain clubs across the university, directing that a notification for the nodal officer of various domain clubs be issued from the Registrar's Office. It was decided that Prof. J.K. Sharma will serve as the overall nodal officer for coordinating these clubs. Each faculty must establish its own domain club with a clearly defined policy framework. Dr. Monika Chahar and Dr. Suman Rathi were entrusted with collecting data on cultural activities, while Dr. Gaurav Dalal was assigned the responsibility for activities related to mental well-being, with a particular focus on yoga initiatives. The value education component will be overseen by Dr. Bablu Sharma and Prof. Sudhir Malik. Dr. Anil Dudy and Dr. Manjeet Kumar will manage documentation and evidence related to sports, and community-focused activities will be coordinated by Dr. Sonia Saroha, Dr. Gaurav Dalal, Dr. Manjeet Kumar, and Dr. Charu Sharma.


The second session commenced at 3:45 PM with a review of Criterion V. Members present included Prof. S.C. Gakhar (Convener), Prof. Mukesh Singla, Dr. Ritu, Dr. Pallavi Bhardwaj, Dr. Sushila, Dr. Vineeta Ahuja, and Dr. Meena. The meeting began with a report on the progress of work accomplished so far. Dr. Meena presented the collected data for Key Indicators 5.1 (Pedagogical Approaches) and 5.2 (Learning Management System). It was stressed that pedagogical approaches must be appropriately reflected, and the LMS portal should be activated at the earliest. The concerned coordinator will prepare and deliver a sensitization presentation for all faculty members on the upcoming Monday in the university's Mini-Auditorium.

The Vice Chancellor instructed the team to gather relevant academic data from the Faculty of Ayurveda, including student assignments and feedback. Prof. Mukesh Singla was designated to support Dr. Meena in this regard. He also reported the progress on Key Indicator 5.3 (Industry-Academia Linkage). Dr. Vineeta Ahuja shared updates on 5.4 (Assessment Components), while Prof. J.K. Sharma provided insights into the data available under 5.5 (Catering to Student Diversity). A substantial discussion took place regarding guidelines for remedial measures and enrichment

courses. It was resolved that data contributions would be coordinated as follows: Dr. Ritu from the Faculty of Law, Dr. Abhishek for Life Skills, Dr. Suman Rathi from the Hindi Department, and Dr. Deepak Yadav from the English Department. The Convener proposed an analytical comparison of first and final semester results across all language departments to assess student enrichment.

Dr. Ritu also presented the status of 5.6 (Academic Grievance Redressal), and was advised to ensure that representative grievance case files are uploaded on the university website for transparency. Dr. Pallavi Bhardwaj reported the data related to 5.7 (Adherence to Academic Calendar), and the Vice Chancellor instructed all members to crosscheck academic calendars to align with UGC norms, which mandate a minimum of 180 working days per academic year.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair, acknowledging his continued support and guidance in steering the university towards successful NAAC accreditation under the Binary Accreditation Framework.
