





- Entire event was filled with joy, colours, and rhythmic beats, promoting cultural harmony and teamwork.

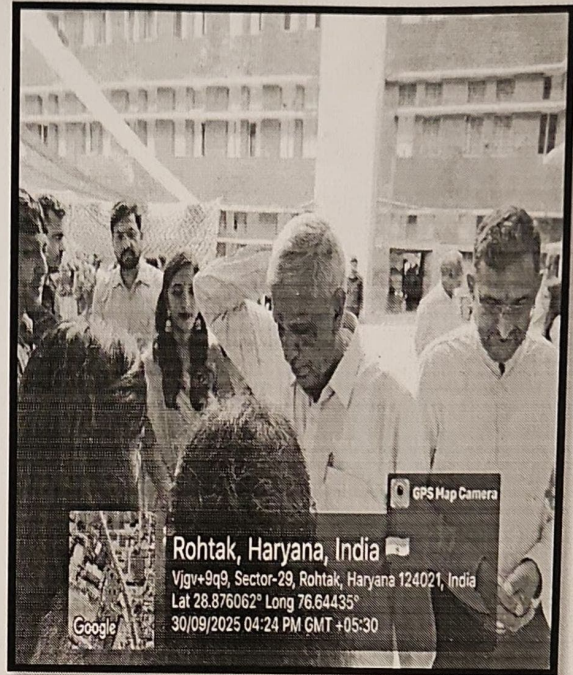

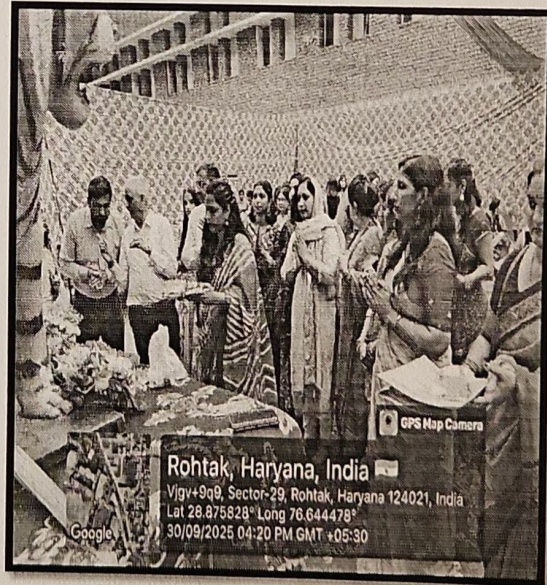

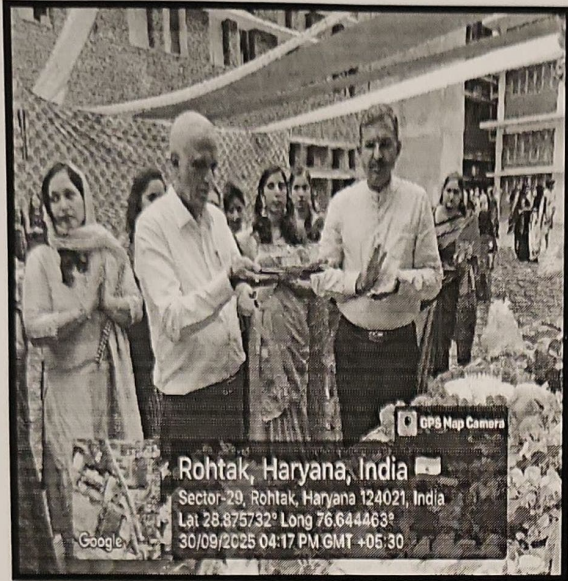
